



Our campsite is pleased to welcome you this summer.

In order to enjoy your stay freely, and according to the latest announcements of the government, starting the 01 of August 2021 you ( persons over 18 years) will have to present your health passport upon your arrival ( only once for the entire stay).

It can be digital or paper printed ( with a QR code to be scanned).

This passport will allow you to enjoy all the activities and recreational places of our campsite during your entire vacation. The health passport is available in digital or paper form; It is a proof of either:

- complete vaccination schedule:
  - 1 week after the second injection for double injection vaccines (Pfizer, Moderna, AstraZeneca);
  - 4 weeks after injection for single-injection vaccines (Johnson & Johnson from Janssen);
  - 2 weeks postvaccination for individuals who had a history of Covid (1 injection only).
- RT-PCR test or negative antigen test of less than 48h.
- or positive RT-PCR tests confirming recovery of Covid-19 at least 11 days and less than 6 months old.

If you live outside of France:

For unvaccinated individuals (complete vaccination schedule), show negative result of PCR test or antigen test (TAG) performed less than 72 hours prior to departure.

For the United Kingdom, Spain, Portugal, Cyprus, the Netherlands and Greece, a test of less than 24 hours is required for non-vaccinated persons.

In order to receive you in the best conditions and to avoid the waiting at the reception, we kindly ask you to fill in the informations in the attached table

**From Friday, July 23 the wearing of a mask is again mandatory in 58 communes of the Var, including the communes of the Golf of Saint-Tropez: Cavalaire-sur-Mer, Cogolin, La-Croix-Valmer, La-Garde-Freinet, Gassin, Grimaud, La-Môle, Le-Plan-de-la-Tour, Ramatuelle, Rayol-Canadel-sur-Mer, Sainte-Maxime, Saint-Tropez.**
